## Emotional Development in Infants & Toddlers

### PITC Module 1, Lesson 7

Infants go through social-emotional stages as they grow; they need to have certain experiences during those stages in order to attain healthy emotional development. Caregivers who understand these stages and needs can help infants expand their confidence and sense of self. Class learning objectives:

- 1) Participants will identify basic physical, social, cognitive, and language milestones of children.
- 2) Participants will recognize individual children's personalities & variations in development and their effects on children's needs in the program.

### PITC Module 1, Lesson 8

As infants and toddlers go through the distinct stages of emotional development, the foundation of later emotional growth is being laid. This class will help you understand how to support infants' and toddlers' emotional growth through the stages. You will visualize an emotionally healthy three-year-old and make decisions about how infants and toddlers should be treated so that they will develop healthy emotional behaviors.
